BASE PROPOSAL

Rates quoted under the Base Proposal will be subject to a fuel surcharge to be added to the quarterly invoices based on the attached Fuel Surcharge Table. This fuel surcharge will be adjusted on a quarterly basis based on the Department of Energy's Energy Information Administration (DOE/EIA) highway diesel price index reading for the Midwest region on the last Monday of the month prior to invoicing.

OPTION #1

Rates quoted under Option #1 will be subtracted from the rates quoted under the Base Proposal.

OPTION #2

Rates quoted under Option #2 will be in addition to the rates quoted under the Base Proposal. This additional charge will be waived in the event a fully automated program is selected by the City.

Under a fully automated program, Rumpke will provide each residence with one (1) 96-gallon trash cart. With the automated collection system, all solid waste must be placed in the trash cart for weekly collection. Large and/or bulky items will be collected one (1) time per month at no additional charge. Additional trash carts will be provided as required to residents for an additional monthly charge.

OPTION #3

Rates quoted under Option #3 will be subtracted from the rates quoted under the Base Proposal.

OPTION #4

Rates quoted under Option #4 will be subtracted from the rates quoted under the Base Proposal.

ADDITIONAL SERVICES OFFERED TO CITY OF HUBER HEIGHTS

Rumpke will provide the following portable toilet service at various City of Huber Heights facilities with no charge to the City during the term of the contract:

- Thomas Cloud Park four (4) units
- Cottonwood Park one (1) unit
- Gary Sherman Park one (1) unit
- Monita Park one (1) unit
- Rip Rap Park one (1) unit

- Shull Road Park one (1) unit
- Yardwaste Drop Area one (1) unit
